GI Joe's HOG up for revival at Clark

CLARK FREEPORT – The most awaited social event during the incarnation of Clark Air Base as the headquarters of the 13th US Air Force, famously the biggest American military installation outside Continental USA, is making a grand comeback this November.

Happening on the Green, better remembered as HOG, was a mix of carnival, fun games, food fest principally American hot dogs, fried chicken, salads, pizza, apples and cherries, fireworks, brass band performances and more that was regularly held to foster a sense of community among the American servicemen and their dependents and the local residents.

HOG 2025 is scheduled to run for two days.

Day 1 dubbed "Nostalgia: Return to the Green" will showcase brass band exhibition and Battle of the Bands featuring Billboard Top 40 hits of the 1970s and 1980s, military vehicle and vintage car exhibitions, outdoor exhibit of HOG through the years, line dancing and country music.

Day 2 or the Grand Family Picnic Weekend will comprise family run, hot air balloons, hot dog eating contest, family costume parade, fur babies fashion show, family movie night, celebrity band, and fireworks display.

The revival of HOG is part of CDC's initiatives showcasing Clark as center of arts, culture, and heritage.

Mayor Jon to review, prioritize DepEd programs

SFELAPCO to relocate power lines for railway project

CITY OF SAN FERNANDO The San Fernando Electric Light and Power Company (SFELAPCO) is set to begin relocating electric lines along key parts of this capital city in support of the government's ongoing North-South Commuter Railway (NSCR) project.

In a statement released this week, SFELAPCO announced that excavations will commence in about three weeks to transfer overhead power lines underground, clearing the way for railway construction spearheaded by the Department of Transportation.

Five areas have been

identified for excavation and cable-laying: St. Dominic Subdivision in Barangay Dolores, Capitol Boulevard in Barangay Sto. Niño, two locations in Barangay Sta. Lucia, and another in Barangay San Pedro Viejo. According to SFELAPCO spokesperson Atty. Cathy Diaz, the underground cable works may take two to three months, while full completion of the relocation project could extend up to six months.

Exclude gov't officials from Bank Secrecy Law

CITING THE very diktat from the 1987 Constitution that "Public office is a public trust," and public office therefore must not be used for self-aggrandizement or for acquiring wealth, Sen. Panfilo "Ping" Lacson has filed two bills aimed at removing bank and foreign currency deposit secrecy protections for government officials and employees.

In separate bills—Senate Bill No. 38 and its foreign currency counterpart—Lacson, a staunch anti-corruption advocate, proposed amendments to RA 1405 (Law on Secrecy of Bank Deposits) and RA 6426 (Foreign Currency Deposit Act) to exclude public servants from deposit secrecy privileges that have long shielded corrupt officials from scrutiny.

"This bill seeks to exclude government officials and employees, whether elected or appointed, from the coverage of the Bank Secrecy Law to equip government authorities with the necessary tools to effectively investigate and prosecute those who misuse public office for personal gain," Lacson said.

He noted that RA 1405, passed in 1955, mandates that all deposits are strictly confidential - but was exploited and used a shield by unscrupulous public officials to evade investigation, "thus obstructing efforts to uncover and address corruption in government service."

Lacson's second bill amending RA 6426 similarly excludes government officials and employees from the secrecy of such accounts.

"The proposed bill seeks to amend the law by establishing a clear and narrowly defined exception: public officials and employees shall not be entitled to the confidentiality of foreign currency deposits. This amendment aligns the statute with constitutional mandates on transparency and accountability, as well as with international standards for financial oversight and integrity," he said.

Lacson noted RA 6426, enacted in 1972, guarantees the confidentiality of foreign currency. This is despite the global shift towards greater financial transparency.

This secrecy makes the Philippines unique in maintaining one of the most restrictive bank secrecy policies worldwide, "thereby impeding the government's efforts to investigate and prosecute tax evasion and money laundering," he said.

Under the proposed amendments, public officers—including members of the Armed Forces of the Philippines, the Philippine National Police, other uniformed services, and government-owned and controlled corporations—will be subject to full disclosure of their bank and foreign currency accounts.

"This amendment aligns the statute with constitutional mandates on transparency and accountability, as well as with international standards for financial oversight and integrity," he said. *From media reports*

CRK-Tower: Showcase of systemic problems in gov't infra protocols By Rene G Romero Business Advocate

THE RECENT COA red flag raised over the construction of the Clark International Airport (CRK) control tower is deeply concerning, especially considering the strategic importance of this infrastructure to Central and Northern Luzon.

From my point of view, the first and foremost accountability lies with the government contract managers and project monitors. It is their mandate to strictly oversee project execution ensuring timelines, quality standards, and contractual obligations are met.

Unfortunately, the lapse in performance monitoring allowed the contractor's non-compliance and construction delays to go unchecked, ultimately compromising not only the timeline but also the integrity of the project delivery.

Secondly, this issue once again highlights systemic problems in our government's bidding and procurement processes. It raises the question: Are we selecting the most capable contractors, or simply the lowest bidders? While transparency in public procurement is essential, it should not come at the cost of competence and project reliability.

It is my hope that this unfortunate episode serves as a wake-up call to correct and reform the mismanagement issues that continue to plague major infrastructure projects.

Reforming, not removing Senior HS

IN HIS proposed Senate Bill No. 3001, Senate President Pro Tempore Jinggoy Estrada wants a "rationalized basic education program" to replace the mandatory SHS level under the country's current K to 12 program, saying it failed to deliver its promised benefits.

While Estrada acknowledges the fact that the SHS program was designed to bring the Philippine education system closer to international standards by serving as a bridge between high school and college, he pointed out that "it has not fully achieved its goal" since the enactment of Republic Act No. 10533, also known as Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013.

If this were a simple program or a project that has failed dismally to serve its purpose, scrapping it altogether might just be the easiest and most practical way out. But that is not the case for the SHS curriculum. Yes, it is flawed but it is not fundamentally broken.

Therefore, it did not come as a surprise that in a joint statement, the Catholic Educational Association of the Philippines and the Catholic Bishops' Conference of the Philippines–Episcopal Commission on Catholic Education pointed out that removing the SHS program from the existing education system "is not only untimely, it is dangerously short-sighted."

They pointed out that what is needed is for the government to commit to a full review of its implementation and institute the necessary reforms without sacrificing the many gains the program has achieved for the past 12 years.

So why should we continue the SHS program? The SHS curriculum aligns the country with the K-12 standard which is essential for international equivalency and mobility. Without it, Filipino students would be disadvantaged abroad, as many countries require at least 12 years of pre-college education.

In a 2023 study conducted by the Philippine Institute of Development Studies (PIDS), SHS graduates earn about 19% more than those who only finished Grade 10 in the Junior High School. This finding validates how the SHS program increases employability and earnings potential.

The program also proves to be a strategic

component in addressing labor market needs. The country continues to face a skills mismatch. Despite a high demand for skilled workers such as electricians, welders, machine operators, there remains a cultural fixation on college among the youth and their parents. Through its Technical-Vocational-Livelihood track, the SHS programs can redirect young learners to technical and vocational jobs, with proper incentives and visibility. With marked improvement in skillsmatching, SHS completers can actually fill real and viable positions in both the local and global labor market.

On the other hand, a tracer study by the PIDS revealed that more than 70% of SHS graduates pursue college not because they find SHS ineffective but consider it as necessary bridge between secondary and tertiary education. These SHS graduates choose college not out of necessity, but aspiration.

So where do the real gaps lie?

Many employers note that SHS graduates often need specialized or extended training before hiring. Industry acceptance remains low as evidenced by a 20% hiring rate from leading firms, according to The Business Manual. Extended immersion from 230 to 800 hours in real work settings and piloting dual-track models could bridge this.

As for curriculum realignment, SHS students will expect decongestion next school year, with no redundant subjects, deeper specialization per strand and competency-based assessments.

Reforming the SHS curriculum by making it leaner, more skills-focused, and industryaligned—is not just preferable; it is essential. It remains a strategic investment in producing a workforce adaptable to global challenges, reducing underemployment, and producing graduates who are both qualified and globally competitive.

Under the DOH-Health **Facilities Enhancement** Program, the major specialty centers which were constructed through a three-year multi-year obligational authority granted by the Department of Budget and Management.

As part of the broader implementation of RA 11223 (Universal Health Care Law) and RA 11959 (Regional Specialty Centers Act) which aims to bring advanced, accessible, and affordable healthcare services closer to the people, the facilities are fully operational and equipped with six state-ofthe-art operating rooms, 125 ward beds, an orthotrauma critical care unit, a burn unit, and a trauma emergency room.

"This is just the second hospital of the DOH system that actually has a robotic system and integrated operating room. But more than the technology, we

The agency made the statement following an inspection on the 18-story New Clark Control Tower on March 25."

SUBSTANTIAL DELAYS

"The completion of the News Clark Air Traffic Control Tower, a critical infrastructure project for the development of the Clark International Airport, remains uncertain due to substantial delays."

Thus, opened the Audit Observation Memorandum of the Commission on Audit dated March 24, 2025, a day before CIAC's inspection of the tower.

COA said the setbacks were due to "poor procurement planning,

are building a system, not just standalone hospitals. The DOH operates the largest hospital network in the world, and if we work as one, we can become the strongest health system globally," enthused Health Secretary Teodoro J. Herbosa.

Herbosa also noted that orthopedic injuries, burns, and trauma are among the most expensive to treat. "By opening these centers, we are lifting the burden from families and hospitals alike. At the same time, we are enhancing regional capacity to save more lives."

The centers are designed to provide both surgical and non-surgical specialty services from advanced orthopedic procedures like spine and microvascular surgeries, to life-saving trauma operations such as craniotomy, thoracotomy, and reconstructive surgery, among others. Dr. Monserrat S. Chichioco, JBLMGH medical center chief, cited the urgency of establishing these centers, noting that a total of 27,740 trauma cases and more than 20,000 orthopedic consultations were logged at the hospital in 2024 alone.

"Originally, we were only tasked to establish 12 centers. The Center for Trauma and Burns is not one of them. But as we analyze our statistics on emergency care and admissions, vehicular accidents and complex trauma cases under these two services are among the top 10 causes of referrals, consultations, and admissions in our hospital. Sad to say, there are significant mortalities from these cases. Hence, we felt the need to strengthen trauma care," she shared.

Chichioco added that more than just an infrastructure milestone, the establishment of

"However, the estimated final completion date remains uncertain and was not specified in the report," COA said.

bamboo forest in Barangay Nabuclod has nursed 108,872 clumps in 536 hectares since 2011, Pineda said, citing data from the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, a partner in the program. She started the bamboo forest project during her first term as governor in 2010.

Pineda ordered a stop to the selling of bamboo poles that fetch only ₱20 apiece and urged Aeta villagers to reserve these

for drying to be made into bamboo chairs and desks that the provincial government will buy for some 12,000 daycare schoolers in Pampanga.

"Nabuclod is an asset because its bamboo forest has grown. We will be training the Aetas in making bamboo byproducts while we supply raw bamboo to furniture makers in Pampanga, Laguna, and Cebu," she said during a meeting with Aeta elected officials and Floridablanca Mayor

Michael Galang. A training center that will double as factory and warehouse will be built in Nabuclod. She also instructed Galang to secure the certificate of ancestral domain title (CADT) of the 5,457-hectare land of Nabuclod Aetas amid reports of land encroachments and illegal sales. The sangguniang panlalawigan, she added. will investigate the CADT status after a probe by the municipal legislative council.

In Friday's launch, Pineda and Gatchalian also visited the farm plots of Aetas in Sitio Camachile cultivated to vegetables in eight hectares inside the Floridablanca National Agricultural School. Social Welfare Undersecretary Diana Rose Cajipe and Assistant Secretary Irene Dumlao accompanied the secretary.

The officials also distributed planting tools, fruit and vegetable seedlings and fertilizers to the

villagers. A total of 1,393 Aeta families received food packs.

"We have to combine immediate assistance with agricultural support and livelihood training so that poverty reduction is more effective," the governor explained to reporters.

Gatchalian supported the initiative by the governor, saying he and DSWD officials will check the progress of the integrated agro-forestry program from time to time. Pampanga PIO
